- My Afghan families who have been separated across the pond and have families over there in the midst of getting here but stuck on some technicality
- For eldest children who are processing all of this but also putting together emergency plans for their family. May God protect immigrant families.
- Prayer for wisdom, divine strategies, and instruction for the protection and care of those in my family and our young adult/college church members.
- My husband is the community and district liaison for our local high school. Our neighborhood is majority immigrant and refugees and families are scared. There were 26 new non-English speaking students last Friday. My husband is the only Latino man in school leadership and being asked for all the answers from families and school leadership. Please pray for wisdom and gospel peace.
- Our church cares for and tutors many children who are from Honduras and part of mixed status families.... I am sure they are scared. Kids who already are separated from family members who are still in Honduras.
- My friend Ted has been trying to get his elderly mother out of Haiti for a year ... all the applications had been completed. She was just waiting....
- For hearts and minds to be changed to follow the arc of the universe bending toward justice. For love, hope, resolve, strength, faith, compassion, and wisdom in these times.
- mom of 4, in the US for 30 years. She is the only one in the household who is undocumented.
- Please Lord give our leaders respect, wisdom, compassion, love and understanding so that they will lead the country well.
